On the homepage under Featured Games, you'll find seasonal versions of all your favorite classic games, including backgammon, blackjack, checkers, chess, mahjong, solitaire, sudoku, word search and more. You can also browse games by category. All games in the 247 Games are completely free and you won't need to create an account to access any features. I didn't come across the ads while playing games on this website. In addition to the desktop version, you can visit the mobile version of the website on your smartphone or tablet to access the same games without downloading apps. Addicting Games Best For: Single-player Games Game Types: Online (Computer Browser), Download (Desktop) and Mobile (Phone/Tablet Browser) The Addicting Games website offers more than 4,500 games in several categories, including action games, simple games, cute games, brainteasers & quizzes and card games. When you visit the site, you'll see ads on the Home screen and on the sides of the page as you play. But at least for me, they didn't noticeably affect the gameplay or user experience. There's the ability to upgrade to a paid Game Pass for an ad-free experience and early access to new games, but it's not necessary to play what you'll see on the site. You can create a free account to keep track of your high scores and favorite games. If you visit a website on a smartphone or tablet, you can play many of the same games without downloading apps. Nevertheless, some games are available only on the desktop version of the website. Many of the games you'll find online at Armor Games are also available as apps for iOS and Android devices, meaning you can download them to your mobile device and continue playing away from your PC. I was impressed by the various games on this website. Although you won't find many famous games like blackjack or You will find a lot of unique and interesting games created by Armor Games and independent developers. You can create a free account on the website to track your high scores and favorite games, but an account is not required to play what is available on the website. Big fish games best for: Games and apps That can be downloaded Game types: Online (computer browser), downloaded (desktops) and mobile (phone/tablet browser, App Store, Google Play) Unlike other websites listed so far, you will need to create an account to play on big fish games. Still, creating an account is easy and free. You will simply need to enter an email address and create a password. Access to thousands of free online games can be found in categories such as hidden object games, casino games, adventure games, puzzles, strategy games, card and board games, family games and more. While many full versions are available for free, some games require paid membership for full access. While there are ads on this website, most of those I've seen have been for the paid membership that Big Fish Games offers as opposed to Google Ads. As I played through several games on the website, I never felt that ads interfered with the gameplay or user experience. In addition to free online games, you will find PC games, Mac games, iPad & iPhone games and Android games available for download. Free online games (FOG) Best for: Independently developed games; Games adapted to mobile browsers Game types: Online (computer browser) and mobile (phone/tablet browser) Free online games (FOG) allow you to play games for free on your computer and on your mobile device without downloading any apps. You'll find a selection of 3D games, action games, defensive games, driving games, flying games, multi-player games and more. While the most popular games on this website seem to be more action-oriented, you can still find classic games like sudoku and chess by looking for them using the search bar at the top of the screen. In addition, you can browse games by category under the More Games tab. During my time at FOG, I saw several ads for other games on the site, as well as video commercials in in-game breaks. While I had to disable my gaming ad blocker, the ads I saw weren't enough to be a major part of the experience on this website. If you wish, you can create a free account using your email address, username, and password to track your progress and rank on high-rating boards. But it is not necessary to play games on the site. Kongregate Best For: Independently developed games, apps and communities Game types: Online (computer browser) and mobile (App Store, Google Play) Kongregate offers more than 128,000 online games in many categories, including action, multiplayer, adventure, strategy and puzzles. Like Big Fish Games, you will need to create an account to play a lot of games on this website. Nevertheless, it is completely free and easy to create one. When you visit the desktop version of the site, you'll see ads at the top and bottom of the page while playing games, as well as a few on the front page. For me, they didn't drastically affect the overall experience. If you visit a mobile version of your site, you'll be redirected to the apps store to download games to your device. Independent game developers can also transfer games to Kongregate, giving you access to thousands of unique titles. MiniClip best for: multiplayer games; 1v1 (one-in-one) games Game types: Online (computer browser) and mobile (phone/tablet browser, App Store, Google Play) If you are a fan of multi-player games or go head-to-head to another player, MiniClip may be worth signing out. In addition to being easy to play as a guest and align with other random online game players, it was also easy to find entertainment codes and invite friends. You will find a variety of games in categories including action, sports, puzzle, games for kids and more. You'll also find games to download on the App Store and Google Play. The most popular games include 8-Ball Pool, Agar.io, Thin Online and Empire. You can create a free account to track your high scores, get on the charts and add friends, but you don't have to: You can play most games online as a guest without having to sign in. While I was playing games on MiniClip, a few pop-up commercials appeared, but otherwise the website wasn't full of ads. When I visited the online version of the website, I could choose whether I wanted to play free games immediately or browse the available app selection for the device I was using. While browsing available games, I found that some full versions were available for free, while other games were only available as free versions or Options. To filter the results, you can click the Free online tab. If commercials really annoy you, MSN Games is a safe place to play. By the time I was on this site, I didn't have to sit through video ads. You can visit the website on your phone or tablet and play available games for free in the browser, but the format was not the best for my iPhone. On a tablet or device with a larger screen, I think games would flow much smoother. Still, many games were available as downloaded apps. Pogo Best for: Hasbro and PopCap Games Game Types: Online (Computer Browser) and Mobile (Phone/Tablet Browser) To play games on Pogo.com, you will need to log into your EA (Electronic Arts) account or create it for free. Once you sign up, you'll see a variety of games available in categories including board games, card games, hidden object games, poker games, puzzles and more. If you're using an ad blocker, you may be prompted to disable it before playing selected games on Pog. Although there were video ads before games and during breaks in the game, they did not significantly interfere with the experience for me. You can sign up for a paid membership that offers ad-free gaming, but it's not necessary to enjoy the site. Some of pogo games are also available on mobile devices and tablets. Unfortunately, some games are only available as free versions and require users to pay to continue playing. Nevertheless, there are tons of completely free options that make Pogo a free gaming website worth visiting. You'll find a variety of online games and games that can be downloaded in categories including puzzles, hidden object games, strategy games, racing games, card and board games, adventure games and more. Although there were several commercials on the home screen and during the gameplay, I was able to leave my adblocker to go through several games before being asked to disable it. Video commercials were occasionally popping during breaks in the gameplay, but I didn't feel like it was taken away from the overall experience. Keep in mind that you won't have to create an account to play games on most of these websites, but if you do, the account is easy and free to create.
